

Substance-related bereavement

Overview

The aim of this course is to improve the support offered to families by enabling those working with individuals bereaved through substance use to understand the bereavement process and effective ways of coping with it.

Learning Objectives

At the end of the training participants will be able to:

- Describe the bereavement process
- Recognise how a substance related death impacts upon bereavement
- Define ways that they can support a bereaved family member
- Recognise ways that bereavement can become severe or 'complicated' and where specialist professional help may be required
- List agencies a family member can be referred to when specialist support is needed
- Identify ways to support themselves whilst working with bereaved families.

How to access this training
